#### 説明

After upgrading from 1.4 to 2.0.3 this morning, I've noticed a change in a custom plugin I had written. The content\_for :header\_tag block does not seem to be being functioning within partials, as in the following example:

This worked just fine in 1.4.x (with the styles/scripts being included on pages that rendered the partial in question), but the stylesheet and javascript tags are completely absent in 2.x (leaving script/style errors in their wake).

Hi Déja, I just came around this issue and decided to test the given behavior by generating a simple sample plugin ( <a href="https://github.com/MischaTheEvil/redmine\_rm11527">https://github.com/MischaTheEvil/redmine\_rm11527</a>). Testing this plugin on a test deployment of Redmine source:/trunk@13366[1], I cannot reproduce the behavior described by you[2]. In my case the plugin's assets are included in page headers also when the @content\_for :header\_tags do@ blocks are used in view partials.

Can you please confirm that the defect you reported is still being experienced and, if yes, test the plugin and provide the results and some more debug info (see [[submissions]] wiki page)?

Looking closely at your example it may even be a simple typo [@content\_for :header\_tag do@ vs @content\_for :header\_tags do@] too...
