Windows 10 x64, Chrome 58.0.3029.110 (64-bit)

I cannot reproduce on vanilla Redmine version:3.3.3 and CentOS 7

google-chrome-stable-59.0.3071.86-1.x86_64.

I Experienced this myself recently, the issue is likely that you have a cached version of the script, try doing a Ctrl + F5 on the page to force chrome to reload all scripts etc. from the server rather than attempt to using a locally cached version
