Users change the columns and apply, and then close the browser, the columns will be reset to default values from Administration-Settings-IssueTracking, while user session is not expired. Show "Issues" of project A, and make some changes (such as sort/columns); 2. Switch to project B, you will find the default setting value for columns and sort of the site is loaded. 3. Switch back to project A, changes made by step 1 is lost, settings for columns or sort is set to site default too.
