The issue to me is that when leaving the Applies Status blank the revisions fail to be linked to the issues.

I would expect either:

- when leaving the Applied Status blank that revisions get linked to the denoted issues but that the issue status remains unchanged
- the Applied Status to be mandatory (non-empty) when saving the Repositories settings

with the former being my personal preference.
